Commonly asked questions...

How long is the course? Generally the group scuba program consists of five evening classroom and pool sessions followed by four ocean dives. This is run in either a two week, Monday to Friday, or weekend format.

Do I get a certification? Upon completion of this program you will be awarded an Openwater Diver Certification Card from an internationally recognized training agency. This certification will allow you to dive independently, buy and rent equipment or partake in Continuing Education Programs.

What equipment do I have to provide? For fit and hygienic issues we strongly recommend that you supply a good quality Mask, Snorkel, Open Heel Fins, Neoprene Boots and Gloves. We will however provide you with all of this equipment as well as all other required gear at no additional cost. You may choose to purchase this equipment within the first week of your program prior to completing Ocean Dives and utilize the discount card included with your registration.

Do I have to be a good swimmer? The only swimming you are required to complete is seven lengths of the pool (not timed) and a ten minute float. We are not looking that you are a strong swimmer but rather that you are comfortable in the water. Scuba is a poor reason to conquer a fear of the water.

What about training materials? Training materials are included with the course. You can take your pick from a wide assortment of training materials including a Manual, CD Rom or Online Interactive Training;
